RESOLUTION NO. 2010-37

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF HCA SPOTSYLVANIA REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER'S APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC NEED FOR RADIATION THERAPY AND RELATED SERVICES FOR CANCER TREATMENT

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2006, the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors passed a resolution in support of Hospital Corporation of America's (HCA) plans to move forward with construction of the Spotsylvania Regional Medical Center; and

WHEREAS, HCA is preparing to open Spotsylvania Regional Medical Center, a facility which will improve patient access and choice, and introduce much needed competition in Planning District 16; and

WHEREAS, the HCA Spotsylvania Regional Medical Center has recently filed an application for a Certificate of Public Need to provide radiation therapy and related services for cancer treatment at its facility; and


WHEREAS, the citizens of Spotsylvania County, as well as the entire region, will greatly benefit from the availability of these services; and
