The voters overwhelming supported this question with a 76% approval rating. The following list represents the items that were included as part of the question:

Work has started on these projects with the top priorities being the three replacement stations at the top of the list. A list of space needs has been developed and this information has been forwarded to our architect so preliminary design work can begin. It is anticipated that these three replacement stations will be completed in the next several years. Once these are complete, other projects will begin. The fire and EMS providers will also reevaluate the needs as the county continues to grow and change. (The Capital Improvement Plan may be modified to address this growth.)
