



SPOTSYLVANIA COUNTY, VIRGINIA Public Notice

ABANDONMENT OF THE SOUTHERN 0.3 MILE SEGMENT OF ROUTE 163 (MALLARD ROAD)

The Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors hereby gives formal notice of its intent to abandon the southern 0.3 mile segment of Route 163, Mallard Road, since it appears to serve no public necessity and is no longer necessary as part of the Secondary System of State Highways pursuant to Title 33.2, Chapter 9 of the Code of Virginia.

The Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors shall hold a public hearing prior to considering the abandonment if one or more landowners whose property abuts the southern 0.3 mile portion of Route 163, Mallard Road, believes that the segment of road serves a public purpose and files a petition with the County. Written petitions shall be filed by October 1, 2018 with the Spotsylvania County Planning Department, Attn: Doug Morgan, 9019 Old Battlefield Blvd, Suite 320, Spotsylvania, VA 22553.
