

Lets all be informed with the Correct Information

Our voting machines are Unisyn brand:

- They do not have a wireless connection and wifi is not available to the units.
- You vote on paper ballots.
- They plug into the wall for a power source.
- Candidates and ballots are approved by the Department of Elections; that information is then programmed per scanner.
- Each system must successfully complete three distinct levels of testing: Qualification, Certification and Acceptance testing.
- Our staff program and test each machine to accept the different ballot styles (and per Congressional District) with a vote for each option. Following confirmation that the machines tabulated correctly, all machines are reset with zero (0) votes and status. They are then certified with all Electoral Board members inspecting and signing printouts from each machine. All machines are then sealed and locked for Election Day morning.
- The County Electoral Board is present and party chairmen are invited to witness the process.
- There is no altering or tampering with our machines before and after this testing.
