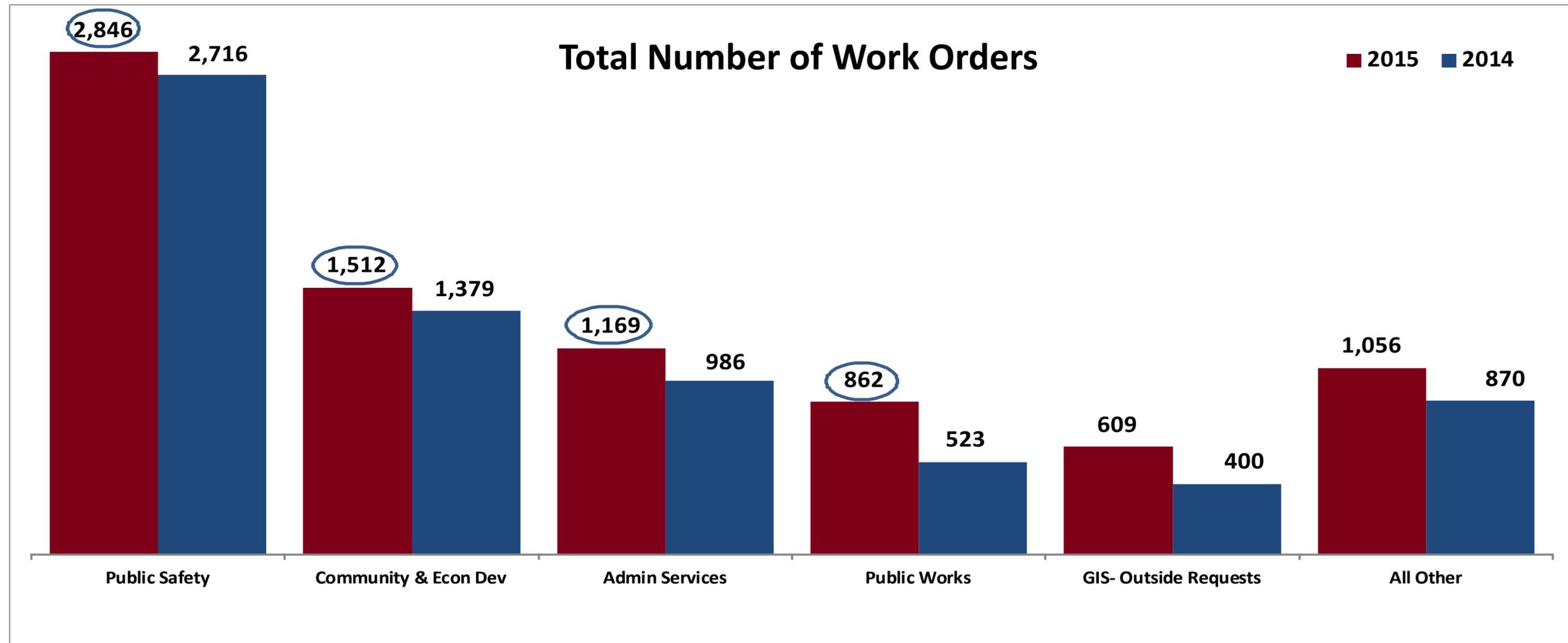

# **New Positions Recommended in the Budget**

## **Applications Development Manager**

- **Position approved but unfunded since 2006**
- **As we continue to move forward with large CIP projects:**
  - **Span of control for program management**
  - **Outside vendor management**
  - **Oversight is critical to ensure projects are on time, within scope and budget**
  - **Resource management (IS and County-Wide)**
- **The applications development manager position will:**
  - **Oversee six project managers**
  - **Ensure that proper guidance and oversight is available**
  - **Establish standards for program management, vendor management, and relationship management with stakeholders**
  - **Provide guidance in the development of personnel.**

# **New Positions Recommended in the Budget**

## **Network Database Administrator (DBA)**

- **Manage continued expansion and growth in county client/server technologies**
- **Oversee and manage expansion of SQL databases**
- **Ensure integrity of the data, interfaces**
- **Establish and enforce security of internal and external access**
- **Align with Disaster Recovery and Business Continuity strategies**
- **Increase lifecycle of systems**
- **Design and implement segregation of roles for database management and data integrity.**
