CHALLENGES

- Volunteers

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

- Resistance to tax increases by citizens
- Resulting Dilemma
- Increasing gap between revenue and expenses
- Actions

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

- Resistance to tax increases by citizens
 - *Citizens faced with the same challenge as the County*
 - Equalized rate = tax increase
 - Car Tax rate = increase
 - Food cost up
 - Insurance costs up
 - Housing/utilities costs up

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

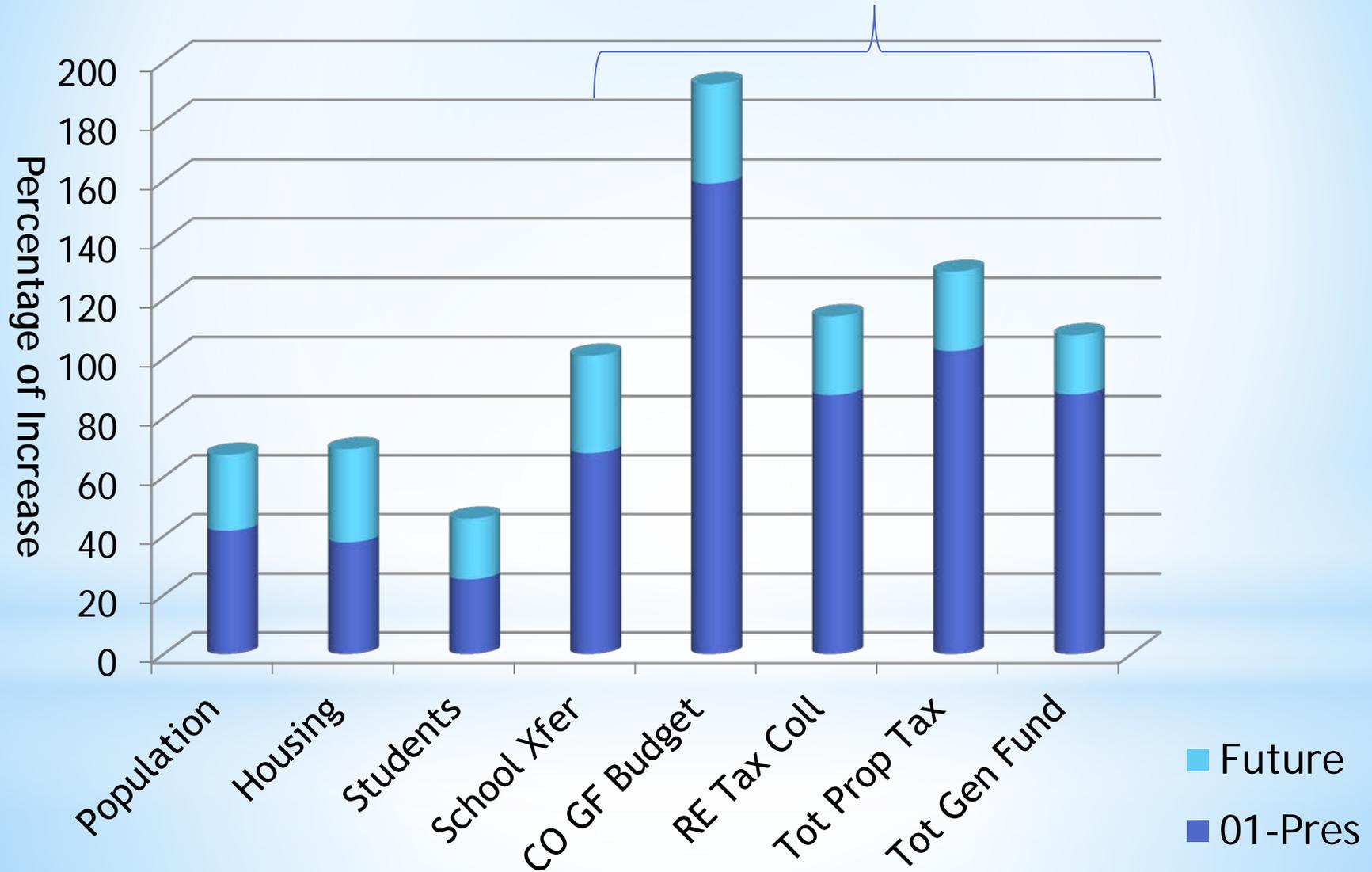
- Resulting Dilemma
 - Citizens have reached a critical point
TO MAKE A CHOICE
 - If same level of services,
more tax even with Equalized rate
 - If same tax level, less services
 - If more services, *more tax* beyond
Equalized rate
 - But Bond Referendum a mixed signal

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

- Increasing gap between revenue and expenses
 - Decreasing revenue from State
 - Changing Federal and State requirements
 - Debt Service Costs up
 - Money to Schools equals 110%+ of Real Estate Property Tax
 - Projected gap = 18%

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

■ Actions

- Eliminate costs for non-essential activities
- Return to FY2014 actual expenditure level for operating costs
- Retain all excess revenue
- Pay-as-you-go through excess revenue
- No tax revenue for any item included in approved bond referendum

SPECIFICS

- Sheriff's Activities
 - Our own Academy
 - Retain part of ticket revenue
- Continue to seek Consolidation
 - Expand the analysis and evaluation
 - Include implementation outline

SPECIFICS

- Pay-for-Performance
 - Must be credible
 - Go slow/Adjust along the way
 - Good performance metrics
 - Figure out performance and work pay into it
