Spotsylvania County's Chapter 8 Erosion & Sediment Control Ordinance (Sec. 8-36 (11)) A provisional erosion inspection in lieu of a final erosion inspection may be given on building lots or sites from December 1 to March 1. A provisional erosion inspection at any other time shall be given only upon approval of and in the discretion of the program administrator. On any building lots or sites with a provisional erosion inspection shall have erosion control measures in place and maintained by the permittee until final grading and seeding of lot or site is complete. Any such, lots or sites having a provisional erosion inspection shall be required to pass a final erosion inspection by May 15 or such other time as determined by the program administrator. Owners, permittees or persons responsible for carrying out the plan who fail to pass the final erosion inspection by the specified deadline above shall be subject to the remedies provided for in this chapter. The program administrator may grant an extension of this deadline for a period of not more than thirty (30) days.
