



SPOTSYLVANIA COUNTY GREENWAYS PLAN

The system of planned Greenway Trails provides a network of long distance off the road shared use paths for a variety of user groups as identified. Greenway Trails are primarily intended to serve as recreational trails but do enhance opportunity for expanding accessibility to goods and services, employment opportunities, access to multi-modal hubs. The greenway system is interconnected with regional scale and national scale systems including the Virginia Central Rail Trail and East Coast Greenway.

There are a number of opportunities for implementing greenway trail development as part of planned road widening projects in the form of parallel to road shared use paths. Those improvements have been reflected in the road based bicycle and pedestrian improvement plan and complement greenway implementation goals.

* Trail head locations are depicted with proximity buffers. Proximity buffers are intended to show the general area where depicted trail heads should be located in relation to the trail system. The trail head locations identified here are not intended to be parcel specific or suggestive of any specific location at this time. Further planning will be necessary to determine where such features are best located.
