Arritt Park – Southeast Spotsylvania; 9718 Wallers Road, Partlow, VA 22534; Located on Route 605 (Waller’s Road); Baseball/Softball fields, picnic shelter and playground; 26.5 acres

Berkeley Community Center - Southeast Spotsylvania; 5959 Partlow Road, Spotsylvania, VA 22551, (Rt. 738) – 2 miles south of Snell, meeting room

Mary Lee Carter Park – Northeast Spotsylvania; 9901 Benchmark Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22408; Located on Route 608; soccer field, walking path and playground, 4.48 acres.

Chancellor Community Center – North Central Spotsylvania; 7300 Old Plank Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407; Located on Route 610 (Old Plank Road), 2 miles west of Five Mile Fork at the junction of Route 626 (Andora Drive); meeting room and Tennis/Pickleball court, .95 acres

Chewing Park – Southwest Spotsylvania; 13013 Post Oak Road, Spotsylvania, VA 22553; Located on Route 606 (Post Oak Road). ½ mile northwest of Mastin’s Corner; Baseball/softball and soccer fields, playground, picnic shelter; 10 acres

Cosner Park – Northeast Spotsylvania; 1 H. C. C. Drive, Fredericksburg, VA 22408; Located off of Route 2 (Tidewater Trail), 2/10 mile south of Tidewater Market. Turn on H. C. C. Drive and go 7/10 mile to the park; Baseball/softball fields, community center, lighted tennis/pickleball courts, basketball courts, soccer field, and playground; 11 acres

Harrison Road Convenience Center Park – Northern Spotsylvania; 5917 Harrison Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407; Located at Chancellor Convenience Site on Route 620 (Harrison Road); Baseball field/ Soccer/football fields, playground, bike/walking trail; 22 acres

Hunting Run Reservoir – Northwest Spotsylvania; 9701 Elys Ford Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407; Located off of Route 3 (Plank Road), boat rental (or launch your own), no gasoline motors, state fishing license required, 20 acres

Lee Hill Community Center – Northeast Spotsylvania; 1 H.C.C. Drive , Fredericksburg, VA 22408; (located off of Tidewater Trail in Cosner Park) , 2/10 mile south of Tidewater Market. Turn on H. C. C. Drive and go 7/10 mile to the park; meeting room, 11 acres

Lee Hill Park – Northeast Spotsylvania; 9910 Lee Hill Park Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407; Located on Route 635 (Lee Hill Park Road), 6 miles east of Route 1; Baseball/Softball fields; 20 acres

Legion Field – East Central Spotsylvania; 8800 Courthouse Road, Spotsylvania, VA 22553; Located on Route 208 (Courthouse Road) in the Spotsylvania Courthouse area. Football field, soccer field, softball and baseball field and track, 24 acres

Lick Run Community Center – North Central Spotsylvania; 6159 Plank Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407 (Rt. 3), 1.2 mile west of Chancellor Community Center, meeting room

Loriella Park – North Spotsylvania; 10910 Leavells Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407; Located on Route 639 (Leavells Road), 1 ½ miles north of Route 208 (Courthouse Road); Swimming pool, lighted tennis courts, picnic shelters, lighted football, soccer, and baseball fields, basketball/multi purpose court, nature trails, playground, open play areas, disc golf course; 208 acres

Loriella Park Swimming Pool – North Spotsylvania; 10910 Leavells Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407; Located on Route 639 (Leavells Road), 1 ½ mile north of Route 208 (Courthouse Road); junior olympic size pool, 3-12 foot pool depth; kiddy pool, snack bar, lifeguards on duty at all times, adult swims every hour, restrooms, locker rooms, open Memorial Day through Labor Day.

Marshall Center – East Central Spotsylvania; 8800 Courthouse Road, Spotsylvania, VA 22553; Located on Route 208 (Courthouse Road), ½ mile south of Spotsylvania Courthouse; Auditorium, Gymnasium, restrooms, locker rooms, classrooms, meeting rooms.

Marshall Park – East Central Spotsylvania; 8525 Courthouse Road, Spotsylvania, VA 22553; Located on Route 208 (Courthouse Road), 1 mile south of Spotsylvania Courthouse; Lighted baseball field, baseball field, lighted basketball courts, playground; 25 acres

Ni River Recreation Area – West Central Spotsylvania; 10516 Gordon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22407; Located on Route 627 (Gordon Road), 5 miles south of Five Mile Fork; Fishing, boat rental (or launch your own), no gasoline motors, state fishing license required, picnic shelter; 5 acres

Patriot Park – North Central Spotsylvania; 5710 Smith Station Road, Fredericksburg, VA, 22407; Baseball Fields, Lighted Baseball Fields, Soccer Fields, Lighted Soccer Fields, Basketball Courts, Walking Trail, Amphitheater; 131 acres

Todds Tavern Community Center – West Central Spotsylvania, 10553 Catharpin Road, Spotsylvania, VA 22553, (Rt. 612) – 2/10 of a mile south-west at junction of Brock Road (Rt. 613), meeting room

Virginia Central Trail – Northern Spotsylvania; Located on the old railway line between Route 620 (Harrison Road) and Route 627 (Gordon Road). A paved 1.9 mile walking/bike trail. Parking is available at Harrison Road Convenience Center Park on Route 620 (Harrison Road)
