The Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors will hold public hearings on the *FY 2022 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022) Recommended Budget, 2021 tax rates, and the draft FY 2022 – FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)*. These public hearings provide a time for speakers to present their views on each subject.

Revised Public Hearing Procedures During the Coronavirus Emergency

- For your safety and the safety of the community at large during this on-going coronavirus emergency, citizens wishing to comment are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to submit written comments to be read into the public record by County staff in front of the Board at the televised hearings rather than attending in person.
- Those desiring to submit written comments to be read publically to the Board may do so immediately by going to the following website www.spotsylvania.va.us/comments, or by placing written comments in the Treasurer's Office drop box outside the Holbert Building at 9104 Courthouse Road, Spotsylvania, VA 22553. Comments submitted via the Treasurer's Office drop box should be in a sealed envelope which is clearly marked with [title of item on agenda]. Written comments not received by County staff by 12:00 P.M. on the day of a meeting are not required to be presented to the Board, so please plan accordingly.
- Additionally, comments may be mailed to the attention of Aimee Mann at PO Box 99, Spotsylvania, VA 22553. Mailed comments must be received by close of business on the Monday prior to the BOS meeting date in order for them to be read into the public record at the hearing.
- Submissions of written comments must include the citizen's name and voting district. Please construct your written comments in such manner that they are limited to three (3) minutes when read at a typical oral reading pace. For comments provided in representation of a group, the time limit is five (5) minutes.
- Citizens choosing to attend in person will be required to maintain recommended social distancing at all times and will be guided by County staff in accomplishing this. If you or a member of your family is sick, in the interest of public health, you are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED not to attend in person, but rather submit your comments in writing to be read aloud and heard by the Board during the public hearing.
- Citizens wishing to speak at the public hearings may sign up starting on Thursday, March 25th by contacting Aimee Mann at (540) 507-7010 or amann@spotsylvania.va.us. Pre-sign ups end at noon on March 30th and will resume at 5:30 p.m. at Courtland High School. The time limit for speakers is three (3) minutes. For a speaker representing a group, the time limit is five (5) minutes providing other members of the group will not be speaking.

Spotsylvania County encourages the participation of all interested County citizens. For those persons with special needs, please notify the County Administrator's Office of any accommodation required at least five (5) days prior to the public hearing. (507-7010, TDD 582-7178)
