Requirements to operate a mobile food prep vehicle

- Valid Driver's License
- Current- License Plates/ Registration
- Current -Vehicle State Inspection/ Paperwork
- Current- Vehicle Insurance Card
- Current- Health Inspection
- Current Fire Prevention- Annual Inspection, Permit and Decal
- Once the permit is approved you will be contacted within 48 hours to schedule an inspection.

Per the VA-Statewide Fire Protection Code (VA-SFPC)

#319

All mobile food Prep vehicles that are equipped with appliances that utilize an open flame or produces smoke or grease laden vapors shall be require to have an annual

inspection and permit issued by Spotsylvania County's

Fire prevention office.

Inspections

- The Fire Official is authorized to conduct such inspections as deemed necessary to determine the extent of compliance with the provisions of all state and local codes.
- The Fire Prevention Office requires a Mobile Food Service Vendor Inspection sticker and annual inspection of the mobile food unit.
- Once the inspection is completed on the mobile food unit, an inspection sticker may be issued. Any Changes to items, processes, storage or configuration within the scope of the Fire Inspection must be approved by the Fire Marshal to maintain the validity of the inspection sticker and to prevent the loss of the permit.
- This is an annual permit, It's valid from January 1st to December 31st.
