

SPECIAL ELECTION – SPOTSYLVANIA COUNTY

Member, Board of Supervisor, Livingston District (for unexpired term to end 12/31/2023)

Voting Early In-Person

- Any registered voter in the Livingston District may vote early, in person, in the Office of Elections (4708 Southpoint Parkway, Fredericksburg, 22407 – next to the Visitor's Center).
- All voters must provide an acceptable form of ID.
- Early Voting will be offered starting December 30th through February 12th. Details below...
 - The office will be open Monday – Friday, December 30th – February 11th from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
 - The office will be **closed** on Friday, December 31st in observance of New Year's Eve.
 - The office will be **closed** on Monday, January 17th in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.
 - The office will be **open** on Saturday, February 5th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - The office will be **open** on Saturday, February 12th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - Saturday, February 12th is the LAST day to vote in person prior to Election Day.
- If you requested to vote by mail and have since changed your mind; please bring your unmarked mailed ballot & corresponding envelopes with you to surrender in order to vote in-person instead.

Absentee / Voting by Mail

Application

- If you have a Virginia issued Driver's License or State ID, you may complete a Vote by Mail application online. Visit vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation. Follow the prompts to apply to vote by mail.
- Call 540-507-7380 to request an application mailed to you.

Submitting Absentee Application

- Print, complete, and sign a paper application.

Deadline to apply

Friday, February 4th is the last day to request an absentee ballot be mailed to you. You may fax or email the application as an attachment or send it by mail to the election's office. Applications must be received by 5 p.m. on February 4th.

Submitting Absentee Ballot

- There is a secure Ballot Drop Box that is available 24 hours a day 7 days a week outside of the Elections Building (by the main entrance, under a security camera)
- The ballot drop box will be available December 30th through Tuesday, February 15, 2022 at 7 PM.
- Ballots are collected and processed daily.
- Vote by Mail ballots may also be mailed to the Office of Elections and must be postmarked by February 15, 2022. Please use the privacy envelope and the self-addressed stamped return envelope provided for you.

Vote on Election Day: **FEBRUARY 15, 2022**

- Local Election: Board of Supervisor, Livingston District ONLY
- Please vote at your precinct – one of five polling places in Spotsylvania.
