Swim lessons provide instruction to help swimmers of all ages and abilities develop their swimming and water safety skills. They are designed to give the students and parents a positive learning experience. Swim lessons teach aquatic and safety skills in a logical progression. The objective is to teach people to swim and to be safe in and around the water. Listed in this brochure are the swim class offerings and the proposed skills your child/you will learn.

**NO ONLINE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE LISTED DEADLINE.**

There will be an additional charge of \$10.00 on all late registrations.

**2.95% NON-REFUNDABLE CONVENIENCE FEE CHARGED ON ALL CREDIT/DEBIT CARD TRANSACTIONS.**

Registration will continue until classes are full or until deadline date.

Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Class sizes are limited.

**NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED PRIOR TO APRIL 1st.**

With over 1,000 class openings, registration continues until July 12, 2019. Classes fill on a first-come, first-served basis. Although some popular times fill quickly, we are happy to accommodate your swim needs with a variety of times and sessions.

Save your registration receipt and this paper to remind you of which session you are registered for.

**You will not receive a reminder from Parks & Recreation.**

**Classes will meet Monday —Thursday, for two weeks.**

**Fridays are reserved as make-up dates.**

**A maximum of two make-up classes will be held.**

**All other cancelled classes will be forfeited (exceptions may be made for extreme weather situations). Make-ups will be held only if class is cancelled, not if you miss class.**

## WAITING LIST

A student may only enroll in one class per session. A student is not permitted on a wait list during a session in which they are already enrolled. Those on the wait list will be called, in the order they were placed on the list, if and when an opening becomes available. Each session has its own wait list. Students will not be rolled over into the next session's waiting list; **an additional registration must be submitted.** The wait list is not an option for online registration.

## CLASS TRANSFERS

After registering for a class, if you later decide to move your child to a different class, you will be charged a \$5.00 transfer fee. Requests for class transfers can be made up to two weeks prior to the starting date of the class, **subject to space availability.** All transfers must be made in person at the Loriella Park office. A transfer request form must be filled out, signed, and \$5.00 fee paid, before a transfer can be made.

## REFUND POLICY

To receive a refund, withdrawals must be made by the registration deadline (at least one week prior to the start of each session). Those wishing to withdraw from the program must do so by contacting the Spotsylvania Parks and Recreation Department. Individuals should follow up their verbal withdrawal request with a written refund request. All refunds are subject to a 20% administrative fee. **A 2.95% NON-REFUNDABLE CONVENIENCE FEE IS CHARGED ON ALL CREDIT/DEBIT CARD TRANSACTIONS.** Failure to attend the class does not constitute a proper withdrawal, and the participant will not receive a refund. Exception: If the withdrawal is due to illness of the child, the child will be allowed to register for a later session at no additional charge, provided space is available. If a child is unable to complete the session due to illness, the child will be allowed to register for a later session and pay only \$10.00, provided space is available. A DOCTOR'S EXCUSE IS REQUIRED IN ALL CONSIDERATIONS FOR ILLNESS.

## INCLEMENT WEATHER

Cancellations due to inclement weather can be heard by calling our cancellation line at 540-898-8546 and/or by signing up for alerts to be received through emails, text messages, or your pager at [www.spotsyalert.com](http://www.spotsyalert.com). Cancellations will be available as soon as a decision is made to cancel. Please listen to the message carefully. If weather conditions are questionable and you do not hear or receive a cancellation announcement, you should report for your swimming lesson. If lessons are delayed by 15 minutes or more due to inclement weather, they will be cancelled.

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**Parent Child “A”—Ages 6-24 months / Parent Child “B”—Ages 24 months-3<sup>1/2</sup> years**

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Parent and Child aquatics builds swimming readiness by emphasizing fun in the water. Parents/guardians and children participate in guided sessions that help children learn elementary skills, including water entry, bubble blowing, front kicking, back floating, underwater exploration and more. Classes are separated by age, NOT skill level.

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**Preschool Level 1—Ages 3-5 *Introduction***

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Preschool Level 1 will help students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely. Skill building will include: Submerge mouth, nose and eyes, blow bubbles through mouth and nose (3 seconds), open eyes under the water and pick up a submerged object held at arms length, show comfort maintaining a back float position with support, begin alternating arm and leg actions with support.

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**Preschool Level 2—Ages 3-5 *Skill Building***

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Preschool Level 2 will build on skills learned in Preschool Level 1. Participants who are already comfortable in the water and with submerging should begin in Preschool Level 2. Skills being taught will include: bobbing, retrieving submerged items from chest deep water, front & back floats with assistance, front & back glides with assistance.

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**School Aged Level 1—Ages 6-12 years *Introduction***

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School Aged Level 1 will help students feel comfortable in the water and enjoy the water safely. Skill building will include: Submerge mouth, nose and eyes, blow bubbles through mouth and nose (3 seconds), open eyes under the water and pick up a submerged object held at arms length, show comfort maintaining a back float position with assistance, begin alternating arm and leg actions with assistance. This class is meant for swimmers who are not yet comfortable in the water or who do not have much experience in or around the water.

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**School Aged Level 2—Ages 6-12 years *Fundamental Skills***

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School Aged Level 2 provides students with opportunities for success with fundamental skills. Skill building will include: bobbing 5 times, retrieving submerged items from water above head level, demonstrate a front glide (2 body lengths), tread water using arms and legs in chest deep water, swim on front using any combination of arms and leg actions (15 feet), swim on back using any combination of arms and leg actions (15 feet).

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**School Aged Level 3—Ages 6-12 years *Stroke Development***

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School Aged Level 3 builds on skills from Level 2 by providing additional guided practice and more in-depth teachings of 3 out of the 4 competitive swim strokes. Participants will begin to demonstrate proficiency in front crawl, back crawl, and breast stroke, while mastering rotary breathing, alternating arm and leg actions, and simultaneous arm and leg actions. The gap between Level 3 and Level is significant. The majority of participants will need to return to Level 3 for at least 2 sessions.

### School Aged Level 4—Ages 6-12 years *Stroke Improvement*

In School Aged Level 4, students build confidence and improve performance of the swim strokes learned in Level 3. Participants will continue working on the 4 competitive swim strokes, while being challenged by the addition of the 2 non-competitive strokes (elementary backstroke and sidestroke). Diving and competitive flip turns are introduced but not mastered.

### School Aged Level 5—Ages 6-12 years *Stroke Refinement*

In School Aged Level 5, participants build on skills learned in Level 4 by providing additional guided practice. All 6 swim strokes are performed independently and are refined with instruction specific to the participant. Dives are performed from sitting, standing and kneeling positions on the pool deck, as well as, off of the diving board. Competitive flip turns and specific stroke transitions are performed independently and perfected.

### School Aged Level 6—Ages 6-12 years *Readiness for competitive swim*

In School Aged Level 6, participants refine strokes to swim with increased efficiency, power, and smoothness, and ease over greater distances. Participants will increase endurance while swimming. Participants are void of a large amount of hands-on instruction, but are rather given sets to complete and skills are fine-tuned based on the participants needs. School Aged Level 6 will mimic the endurance and practice structure of competitive swim teams.

### Teen/Adult Swim Classes—Ages 13 years & older

A great class to get you comfortable in the water while learning the basics of swimming. Swimmers can work at their own pace with help and instruction.

### Beginner Level for Special Needs—Ages 4-17 years *Introducing water skills*

Special Needs Classes provide participants with opportunities for success with fundamental skills. Skills will be based on class participation and will move in a fashion that is suitable for the class as a whole, based on individuals needs. Special Needs classes are separated by age and will include instruction that is appropriate for the age and skill level of the class.
