

Jeremiah Hansen toured County and School Maintenance facilities and had several comments about inventory controls at those facilities. County staff provided the following response:

In FY 18 Utilities/Public Works is actively developing the Cityworks work order platform that is heavily GIS asset based. This form of work order system is more useful in the Utility/Public Works field as it can create life histories of assets deployed in the field, for example an individual fire hydrant or valve. Included in this deployment is a storeroom module that is being applied to the Utilities operations. It is the intent of the Department to apply this storeroom module to the County maintenance program over the next few fiscal years. The Department plans to eventually expand the storeroom program to include barcode scanning of all inventory control. In the meantime Staff will review manual inventory control features and look for way to improve those controls.
