Prerequisite(s): It is recommended that the student have experience in the theory and use of basic hand tools. Students must be a minimum of 18 years old.

Description: A course designed for fire and rescue personnel with basic and intermediate experience in vehicle rescue. Classroom and practical evolutions will alert students to new hazards associated with today's vehicles. Time will be spent on how the laws of physics affect the vehicle, its' passengers, and the outcome this has on tactical considerations. Emphasis is placed on the development of safe and efficient techniques for vehicle stabilization and lifting, and in the use of air bags and hydraulic rescue tool systems.

***This is a certificate of attendance course. This is not the HTR-Vehicle Level I program. Students pursuing progression with the complete technical rescue program will need to follow the matrix as outlined by the new VDFP technical rescue training programs. ***

Class Size: 24 Maximum - This class is being conducted within the Volunteer Firefighter Academy and 20 seats are being reserved for these students. There will be 4 seats available.
