Board Question #: 22

BUDGET QUESTION: How many full-time and part-time detective positions currently exist? What is the caseload per detective?

RESPONSE: The Criminal Investigation Division (CID) with the Sheriff's Office currently has 14 full-time detectives carrying an average case load of 16-18 cases per month. The division also has four part-time detectives that are carrying an average case load of 6-8 cases a month. These detectives include members of general assignment and child victim unit (CVU).

Three additional full-time detectives are assigned to narcotics and are not included in the general assignment and CVU case load due to their specific role. One additional part-time detective is assigned to Administrative Service Division for backgrounds and internal affairs investigation (internal affairs investigations are not done through CID due to conflicts regarding Garrity v New Jersey).
